A Message from the Secretary

One of the most painful budget writing sessions in state history is finally over. While we suffered some cuts, CCPS fared better than most departments in part because our public safety mission is so important. Unfortunately, we lost seven badly needed ALE positions, four in EM, and seven others scattered across the department. By cutting vacant positions, we were able to avoid layoffs. Those cuts hurt deeply, but we have no choice but to continue focusing on our core missions.

There is some good news. We received additional money for two programs that have been grossly underfunded. The Crime Victims Compensation Fund will have another \$2.5 million for crime victims and the National Guard will get an additional \$900,000 for tuition assistance so that members can continue their education while serving their state and nation. And while the General Assembly did not find the money to give pay raises, full time, permanent state employees will receive an additional 10 bonus days of vacation. That is a benefit that you certainly deserve, and if we could do so, your department and division leaders would give you more. We are extremely grateful for your hard work and dedication to making North Carolina a safer place to live and work. Thank you.
